PLEASE NOTE: If you no longer own a vessel, traded, sold or purchased a different vessel or if your vessel is no longer in Braintree waters, it is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to inform the Braintree Assessor's Office at 781-794-8050. If you fail to do so, **YOU WILL BE** accountable for all applicable taxes, fees and penalties.
